

Sarah Law's new collection of poems is inspired by medieval Norfolk visionary Margery Kempe. From prose poems to song lyrics, these poems draw on Margery's life and visions while often taking unexpected turns of their own.

SOLDIERS

SOLDIERS David Cottrell

Local artist David Cottrell is opening his studio to the public during
COAST 2014 and will be displaying paintings on the subject of War and
Peace.

"The paintings I will be showing will include three or more soldier's heads
These images emerged from an interest in the ambiguity of newspaper
clippings which I often distorted further before painting from them. I like
the suggestive nature of the images from which I occasionally work as
opposed to their clarity.

In the case of these images of soldiers, this obscurity seemed to remove
us further from conflicts already obscured by time, distance and politics.
The very ambiguity of these newspaper images seemed to evoke an
ominous sensation of war.

All information on conflicts in foreign lands comes to us filtered and
obscured by time, distance and the limitations/intent of the media etc. It
interests me that painting can become as much about the way we receive
information (the way images come to us and are distorted in the process)
as the subject itself.

The act of painting also, of course, interests me. As such, these pictures are
about mark making and abstraction; the duality of image and surface".






